Spiritual Practices:

<u>Vegetarianism</u> (because animals have the life force in them) <u>Meditation</u> (to keep mind calm; prayer-like) <u>Yoga</u> (philosophy with breathing, movement/exercise) <u>Doing one's job or duty in life</u> (based on the caste system) <u>"Om"</u> (<u>aum</u>): sacred sound, usually precedes prayers and meditation (made up of all other sounds in the universe)

One life force, many deities: Henotheistic—a major god + other "smaller" gods
