Roman Gods: Similar in function to Greek gods; different names (borrowed from the Greeks): Zeus → Jupiter Hera → Juno Poseidon → Neptune Apollo → Apollo Aphrodite → Venus Ares → Mars Later, Roman Catholicism Planets named after Roman gods Days of the week after the planets Julian calendar (later became Gregorian calendar which we use today) July, August Holidays: April Fool's Day Sports Colosseum/Coliseum (gladiators) Circus Maximus (chariot races) Concept of stadiums Art Mosaics Bas-Relief Oratory (speech-making) Cicero Language Romance languages (Spanish, French, Portuguese, Italian, Romanian—all once ruled by Rome) Architecture Vaulted ceilings Arches Domes Use of marble instead of brick Concrete Aqueducts Constructed roads (use of layers) Idioms: When in Rome, do as the Romans do. All roads lead to Rome. Rome wasn't built in a day.
